Filetype Format name Description .pem Privacy Enhanced Mail (PEM) Base64 encoded DER certificate, that uses: “—BEGIN CERTIFICATE—” and “—END CERTIFICATE—” .cer .crt .der Security CERTificate Usually binary DER form, but Base64-encoded certificates are common too. .p7b .p7c Structure without data, just certificates or CRLs.

PKCS#7 is a standard for signing or encrypting (officially called “enveloping”) data. .p12 PKCS#12 May contain certificate(s) (public) and private keys (password protected). .pfx personal information exchange (PFX) Older format. Came before PKCS#12. Usually today data is in PKCS#12 format.

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
